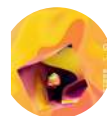
OPEN-AIR EXHIBIT

Included in "Back To Nature 2021: Contemporary Art at Villa Borghese", the museum Carlo Bilotti inside Villa Borghese will host the exhibition "Art and Nature. The itinerary will center on significant works coming from the city's museum collections and spanning the period from the 1960s to present day, with the further intention of introducing the public to a lesser-known heritage.
