Eataly is celebrating seafood and wine and bringing the sea to their restaurants this summer. Fish & Wine is running from July to September, with new seafood dishes to Eataly's menu.

Every week, Eataly will celebrate one maritime Italian region with their culinary traditions and wineries. In August, you'll be able to try a 3-course tasting menu from Campania (Cantina Feudi di San Gregorio), Latium (Vini Cantine Silvestri), Sardinia (Vini Cantina Mesa), Abruzzo (Vini Poderi Marchesi Migliorati, Cucina Pastorie), and Tuscany continuing in September (Vini Cantina Montellori).

Once a week, one restaurant from the week's region will propose its own tasting menu and wine. Birreria Eataly will also add a new delicious fish burger to their menu every week, paired with a fritto and a craft beer.

# MOONLIT MOVIE NIGHTS

### **CINEMA**

### Various locations

What better way to escape the August heat and respect social distancing than watching a movie under the night sky with a friend or a few as you sip a cold drink, bite into a slice of pizza, or eat a delicious gelato? Luckily, the season of moonlit movie nights continues with more dates, screenings, and special guests in various locations within the Eternal City.

The events hosted by Cinema America at Cinema in Piazza are over for 2021, but the magical **Caleidoscopio at Casa del Cinema** in the heart of Villa Borghese still has a lot to (info casadelcinema.it). Every day of the week, a new screening dedicated to the stars of Italian and international cinema awaits you starting at 9pm, free of charge.

**Tim Vision Floating Theatre** is also on until September, providing a unique experience literally floating on EUR's laghetto. Screenings start at 9pm with a  $\in$ 6 fee (info floatingtheatre. it/).

There are plenty of other arenas and open spaces in Rome offering all kinds of movies, from classics to previews to new releases to indie productions to Oscar-winning films. Among the many locations, **Arena Garbatella** has over 500 seats and is showing a film per night until August 16 (info: arenagarbatella.it); **CineVillage Parco Talenti** until August 8 (info cinevillageroma.18tickets.it); **Arena Tiziano** is on till September. Some are completely free of charge and some have an entry fee; some also require a reservation, so make sure to check out their respective websites to view their rules and programmings.



Sagras are perhaps an Italian foodie's best-kept secret. These rustic festivals have centuries-long traditions and are very tied to the land and the people hosting them. Sagre center around regional produce or recipes or drinks or ingredients, and are composed of vendors offering samples of their products and dishes starring the protagonist of the sagra. Often there are also competitions and different sorts of events. If you want to try some delicious food that you might not always come across in the City, check out this list of top 8 sagre happening this August in Latium!

## CASA BALLA: FROM THE HOUSE TO THE UNIVERSE AND BACK

MAXXI is celebrating the 150th anniversary of Giacomo Balla's (Turin 1871 – Rome 1958) birth with an incredible exhibit split between the museum and Balla's own apartment in Via Oslavia. "Casa Balla: From the house to the universe and back" showcases the themes of the Futurist movement and how timely they still are today. The exhibit is an extraordinary project in collaboration with various institutions: MAXXI, the Soprintendenza Speciale di Roma Archeologia Belle Arti e Paesaggio, with the support of Direzione Generale Creatività Contemporanea del Ministero della Cultura.

The exhibit is a "total" project, highlighting the all-encompassing idea of art that Balla had. The apartment in the Della Vittoria/Prati district is open to the public for the first time and it represents a testament to the artist's experimental universe. Each room is an experience in itself, adorned with the artworks of Balla and his daughters Luce and Elica, who were also painters.

Different objects, picked and built by Balla, cohabit with hand-painted walls and doors, paintings and sculptures, constituting an experimental artistic project that involved Balla's life at 360 degrees.

The house expresses the artist's full personality and is perhaps his truest masterpiece. Through the opening of the apartment, we can regain a part of our artistic DNA from the past century that changed the conception of art forevermore. The exhibit continues at MAXXI (in the museum's Galleria 5), where contemporary Italian and international artists open our eyes to the legacy that Futurism left to current art.

Juxtapositions and intersections between different media, different languages, different techniques, a strong bond with everyday life and the constant challenge to the limits of traditional categories of expressions are the protagonists of the MAXXI exhibit, showcasing the impact that Giacomo Balla's work still has on 21th century art. Eight artists help us in this realization: Jim Lambie, Leonardo Sonnoli, Ila Bêka and Louise Lemoine, Alex Cecchetti, Emiliano Maggi, Carlo Benvenuto, Cassina with Patricia Urquiola, and Space Popular.


As is made perfectly clear by this calaidoscopic exhibit, Giacomo Balla imagined a modernity that feels very familiar to this day: the overcoming of barriers, contamination of genres, the identification of art and life.

Casa Balla is open between Fridays and Sundays until November 21; in order to guarantee social distancing, visits only last 45 minutes and no more than 10 people can visit at the same time, therefore booking is mandatory. Tickets can be bought along with the MAXXI exhibit or separately; the two visits can occur on different days. The museum exhibit follows MAXXI's regular opening hours (closed on Mondays).
