The Roma Gospel Festival is held annually at the Auditorium Parco della Musica and features the best American choirs and gospel groups and is the largest of its kind in Europe. With such a venue, the goal to involve all listeners and have them participate in the shows is easily achievable. So don't hesitate to wave, sing along, or simply clap with everyone else for a unique and encompassing experience.



The festival will host a variety of groups - such as the **Eric Waddell & The Abundant** (23 Dec), Baltimore's premiere gospel choirs; and the **Harlem Gospel Choir** (25 Dec), the most celebrated gospel choir in the United States, known for collaborating with international artists such as Diana Ross, Bono, and more. The stage will hear the four phenomenal voices of **Light of Love** (26 Dec), a particular style of rather modern gospel, and **Dennis Reed & Gap** (27-28-29 Dec). Dennis Reed is a pianist, vocalist and leader of the GAP (God's Appointed People) group, who he created that conquered the American gospel music scene. From the 27th to the 29th of December, don't miss the Dennis Reed Workshop, a gospel music laboratory curated by him.

The festival concludes with **Emmanuel Djob by the Gospel River** (30-31 Dec), who is one of the best soul/gospel voices of Europe, winner of the French edition of The Voice.

This is an event that delivers to its audience the beauty, splendour, and depth of classical and contemporary Gospel music.

On the occasion of the seven hundredth anniversary of Dante Alighieri's death, the Scuderie del Quirinale brings together an international exhibition with more than two hundred works by different artists about the concept of hell and damnation from the Middle Ages to the present day.

A powerful, ambitious and spectacular exhibition, capable of taking the visitor to unexpected territories through the power of images and the depth of ideas. Accompanied by the words of Dante, visitors will cross the terrifying places and the heartbreaking visions of Hell represented by artists of all ages: from schematic medieval scenes to sublime Renaissance and Baroque inventions, from tormented romantic visions to relentless analytical interpretations of the 20th century.

The exhibition's itinerary unfolds through works of art borrowed from more than eighty major museums, public collections and prestigious private collections, coming from different countries in Europe. Among the masterpieces present in the museum, there are many renowned artists, such as Botticelli, Manet, Rodin, Cézanne and among many others.

The exposition is based on the chants of the epic and theological poem written by Dante in the 14th century, the Divina Commedia. The idea of a final judgment appears in many paintings with strong images of the counterpoint between those who go to Paradise and those who go to Hell. Paintings that show the horrors of Hell and its inhabitants are also complemented by a section addressing the Devil's metamorphosis, exposing its various faces and how it has been portrayed throughout history.

After 110 years of having participated in the 1910 Venice Biennale with a personal room, the works of the Austrian painter Gustav Klimt are once again being exhibited in Italy, at the Museum of Rome in Palazzo Braschi. The exhibition "Klimt. La Secessione e l'Italia" shows the stages of Gustav Klimt's entire artistic trajectory, highlighting his role as the co-founder of the Vienna Secession and his relationship with Italy – narrating his travels and his successes in exhibitions in the country.

Klimt and the artists in his circle are represented by more than 200 works, including paintings, drawings, posters and sculptures, loaned from public and private collections and the Belvedere Museum in Vienna and the Klimt Foundation.

Klimt's ambivalent view of women draws attention to a much-debated topic in Vienna at the beginning of the 20th century: the relationship between the sexes. The role of men and women in society, eroticism and sexuality, are subjects seen throughout many works exhibited in this exhibition. Klimt's work is heavily focused on portraits, where he demonstrates an incredible mastery of painting techniques, both in photo-realistic and impressionistic shading. In each portrait, it seems he is looking for new inspiration, one being always different from another. He also explored the theme of landscape, having created paintings of idealised nature, a heavenly, cloudless world.

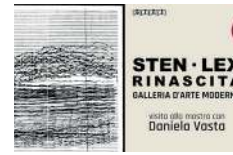
