This is one of the best events in Rome and this fabulous competition will combine men's and women's tournaments. This tournament will give us a week of intense tennis under the glorious sunshine of May.

You will be able to admire the 10-times winner and defending champion Rafael Nadal, the five-time champion Novak Djokovic, Stefanos Tsitsipas, Alexander Zverev, the new rising star Alcaraz, along with the Italian star Jannik Sinner and many others. Among the female protagonists you will admire the defending champion Iga Swiatek, Simona Halep, and Elina Svitolina.

The tournament is one of the three ATP World Tour Masters 1000 events contested on clay. The event is more than just tennis: it is a total entertainment experience. This experience includes high fashion, fine food, fabulous shopping, and celebrity musical performances have made the tournament one of the most glamorous stops on the ATP World Tour.

On the 21st and 22nd of May, everyone will have the chance to explore the great architecture and design of contemporary structures, historical buildings, and even private houses all over Rome. Thanks to Open House Rome (an international event, which involves every year 50 cities in the world), more than 200 sites will open their doors for two days to visitors and tourists alike.

This is the 10th edition of Open House Rome.

The program includes iconic places, such as cultural institutes, representative offices, and academies (the Egyptian Academy, the Danish Institute, Villa Medici – French Academy, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation), museums, historic buildings, sites of scientific and cultural interest. The highlights of this year include the park and solar tower of villa Mellini the headquarters of the astronomical observatory of Rome, San Michele tower in Ostia, Angelini headquarters, Palazzo Piacentini on via Veneto, Forte Pietralata, former pasta factory of Pantanella, Casino dell'orologio in Villa Borghese, and Luiss' Villa Blanc.

After 89 years, Rome's beautiful Villa Borghese gardens is once more preparing for its world famous and glamorous International Horse Show. This four-day event features top

international riders competing in traditional riding displays, as well as thrilling show-jumping. Also a polo match is in programme. Piazza di Siena takes its name from the city of origin of one of the most ancient and noble families of Rome: the Borghese. At the end of 16th century, Prince Marcantonio Borghese commissioned to architects Mario and Antonio Asprucci a new space, able to recall the places he beloved. His desire, in fact, was to bring, in the city of Rome, the traditional popular celebrations atmosphere they enjoyed, since the Middle Ages, in Tuscany.

From April 28 to June 12 the exhibition of the World Press Photo 2022 returns to the Palazzo delle Esposizioni in Rome. The exhibition presents a national preview of the finalist photos of the international photojournalism competition which since 1955 awards the best professional photographers every year. For this 65th edition, global and regional juries made up of international experts have received 64,823 photos, sent by 4,066 photographers from 130 countries. Amber Bracken was named the winner of photo of the year with his shot "Kamloops Residential School". It shows a row of clothes hanging from wooden crosses along a road, in remembrance of indigenous children who died at Kamloops Indian Residential School, following the detection of 215 presumed unmarked graves that may belong to children who attended school in Kamloops, British Columbia, Canada.
