GOSPEL

The Roma Gospel Festival is held annually at the Auditorium Parco della Musica, from December 23 to December 31. The festival features the best American choirs and gospel groups and is the largest of its kind in Europe. With such a venue, the goal to involve all listeners and have them participate in the shows is easily achievable. So don't hesitate to wave, sing along, or simply clap with everyone else for a unique and encompassing experience.

The **Florida Inspirational Singers** mark the opening of the event on **December 23**, bringing a uniquely gospel repertoire, where the deep soul of the southern US tradition blends with the more modern, spiritual, sounds of the genre.

On **Christmas Day** there will be a double performance by the **Harlem Gospel Choir**, the most famous and long-lived US gospel choir, which has been performing since 1986 to raise funds for charity.

On **December 26**, the very young **The Brooklyn Gospel Harmonettes**, led by front leader Jamia Jean Pierre, will land in Italy for the first time, ready to tell their Afro-American story through the purest Gospel tradition.

This is followed by three days of performances (**27-28-29 December**) by the **Brent Jones Gospel Choir**. Brent Jones is a producer, musician and choirmaster, who, with his urban group Brent Jones & T.P. Mobb laid the foundation for contemporary gospel music.

The festival ends on **December 30 and 31** with **Nate Martin & Sign** (Singing In God's Name), the Chicago duo with a robust sound and an example of Gospel Soul made in the USA.

Five, selected from over the 300 reviewed over the past four months, are the short films that will be screened this December: August Sky, Lions, Du Boit Des Doigts, Guinea Pig, and Tsutsué, coming from as far as Iceland, but also from France and Italy. Some of these have a presence in Cannes, whereas others are being screened for the first time ever.

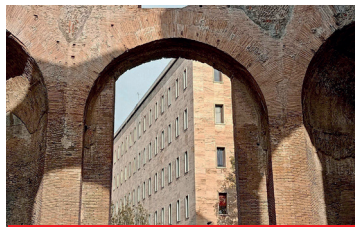
The 59th Nuova Consonanza Festival – Musica in Movimento (music in motion) is a journey through the ideas of narration, performance and

What does a city sound like? This is the key question of the Creature festival as it examines the relationship between the shape of space and the mechanics of sound waves through exhibitions, performances and audio-visual arts. The event that Creature has planned for this December is "Rmx", which proposes a sound path conceived by the MetaDiaPason collective; a heterogeneous tale of the sounds produced by the artists involved in the festival such as Teho Teardo, Riccardo Sinigaglia, the Beng!Band Jazz, Adriano Viterbini and Ice One. The event will take place at the Tempio di Minerva Medica, a place nestled between the tracks of Termini Station and the Rome-Pantano light railway, where the feeling of isolation is continually interrupted by the clanking of trains, the twinkling of pantographs and the distant whistle of trains arriving at the station. The event is free, but you must book yourself a slot through the website.

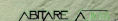

MAXXI, the National Museum of 21st Century Arts, hosts thought-provoking and colorful exhibitions from the contemporary art world. Designed by controversial architect Zaha Hadid, MAXXI is an unconventional space both inside and out. This striking building is composed of giant intersecting concrete segments that seem severe from the outside, but inside create flowing pathways that gently transport the visitor through this modern, open-plan space.

The acute observation of power dynamics, the effects of massive media consumption on the public and the voice of the artist as an act of protest and prophecy are some of the themes that articulate the sections designed for the exhibition. At MAXXI, the politics integral to Pasolini's thought and art are rendered through the works of several artists attentive to the painter's devotion to a politics from below and a constant interrogation of and doubt about the heroism of the rational subject of a secular, bourgeois, neo-capitalist world.

BOB DYLAN. RETROSPECTRUM

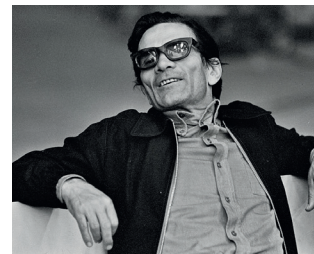

In this exhibition, Dylan's multifaceted nature is explored through a wide range of works, ranging from oil paintings, acrylics, watercolours, ink, pastel and charcoal drawings to a series of iron sculptures. The selected works represent a visual diary documenting the transformation of sources and styles that have inspired and influenced him over the years. Through new and ongoing encounters with changing environments and people, the exhibition shows how his work has constantly evolved in exciting ways, reflecting the sensibility of a genuinely artistic voice.

Vibrant, electric glimpses of paint combined to create lively open-air social scenes: regattas, urban streets, hippodromes and much more. This is Raoul Dufy's universe where colours play a key role.

Largely neglected and undervalued because of the apparent frivolity of its themes, the works of the French painter (1877-1953) come back to Rome with a great exhibition which can be visited until February 26.

At Palazzo Cipolla, placed halfway between Montecitorio and Piazza Venezia, a great selection of the Fauvist painter's work is on display. The exhibition includes about 160 pieces distributed through the ground floor of the building which peculiar denomination ("cipolla" stands for the word onion in the

Italian language) traces its origins in the surname of the architect who designed the palace in 1864.

The artistic event, organized in collaboration with many important institutions such as the the Musée d'Art Moderne de la Ville de Paris, is a unique opportunity to discover the artist's multifaced talent: Dufy was a painter, a printmaker, a book illustrator, a scenic designer, a designer of furniture and a urban planner.

Through 13 thematic sessions, the exhibition "Raoul Dufy, painter of joy" explores the painter's career through his masters and his close links with the South of France and his contemporary Paul Cezanne.
