Spring Attitude, the international festival of music and contemporary culture, returns for its twelfth edition on September 23rd and 24th in Rome at the Cinecittà Studios. It is a highly symbolic and evocative location that mesmerized over 16,500 people last year, with a sold-out event.

This long-standing event has become an unmissable and increasingly established gathering, capable of capturing current trends while also discovering new ones. It has always been attentive to cross-genre and cross-style contaminations. Therefore, it is no coincidence that the theme for the 2023 edition is "Naturae," a Latin plural that represents and identifies the festival's diverse musical and artistic souls.

The headliners for the 2023 edition include Moderat, the German trio that has been one of the most exciting acts in the electronic music scene of the past decade, with their successful latest album "MORE D4TA." Also, Peggy Gou, the South Korean DJ based in Berlin, already acclaimed as one of the deities of electronic music. Lastly, Verdena, who are coming off the triumph of their latest album "Volevo Magia" and an almost entirely sold-out tour.

In 2015, Rome was selected to host the 44th edition of the biannual international golf competition, Ryder Cup 2023. This is the most important men's golf tournament, played between the best players of Europe and the United States. This fall, Marco Simone Golf and Country Club, 10km outside of Rome, will serve as an official venue of the competition.

The tournament will take place from September 29th until October 1st (the practice sessions will begin on September 25th). Each of the first two days includes one four-match session of four-ball and one four-match session of foursomes. The final day is reserved for 12 singles matches.

The Ryder Cup originated in the United States in 1927 and was named in honor of Samuel Ryder, a British entrepreneur who provided the trophy as a donation. The tournament emphasizes the prestige of an old-school golf tradition and the friendly competition between the Old and New Big-West. It is the only sporting event in which Europe competes as a single team. The tournament is held every two years, alternating between cities in Europe and America.

# THE BEST THINGS TO SEE AND DO AT THE VATICAN MUSEUMS

The Vatican Museums are one of the most important international museum centres. Here you can admire some of the most prestigious historical collections and some of the world's masterpieces. Giotto, Raphael, Michelangelo, Caravaggio and Leonardo are just some of the names in the Vatican. Here is a list of what you mustn't miss in the museum complex.

# The Sistine Chapel

With frescoes unparalleled beauty, the Sistine Chapel hosts some of the greatest painters, such as Sandro Botticelli, Pietro Perugino, Domenico Ghirlandaio and Cosimo Rosselli... plus, the one and only Michelangelo Buonarroti, who was commissioned to paint the vault giving the place the highest form of artistic expression.



# Raphael's Rooms

The Raphael Rooms (le Stanze di Raffaello) were part of the flat chosen by Pope Julius II della Rovere as his residence and located on the second floor of the Papal Palace. The pictorial decoration of the Stanze was carried out by Raphael Sanzio and his pupils. The Stanze are: Hall of Constantine, Room of the Segnatura, Heliodorus' room and the Room of the Fire in Borgo.



# Room VIII

Room VIII, is one of the most significant rooms of the Pinanoteca. The room is dedicated to Raphael and houses three of the great artist's altarpieces and tapestries. A warm but soft light illuminates the beauty, colors, and materials of each of the works. It also creates an intimate and welcoming environment where each visitor is invited to pause in silence and meditation.





# Pinacoteca

Some masterpieces by the greatest artists in the history of Italian painting are kept in the Pinanoteca Vaticana, which houses a collection of about 460 works, arranged in eighteen rooms. The collection includes masterpieces from Giottoo some of the best artists of all times, from Giotto to Beato Angelico, to Melozzo da Forlì to Perugino, Raphael, Leonardo, Tiziano, Veronese, Caravaggio and Crespi.



# Gallery of Maps

One of the most evocative and original sights to be found along the tour of the Vatican Museums is the gallery of maps. The Gallery was built between 1580 and 1585 and decorated with beautiful frescoes depicting the maps of the regions of Italy by Italian and Flemish artists.

# The Borgia apartment and the pontiff's secret chambers

Among the rooms to visit in the Vatican Palaces it is essential to include the sumptuous decorative complex of the Borgia Apartment, residence of Pope Alexander VI, painted by Pinturicchio, The Borgia Apartment, which occupies the entire first level of the Apostolic Palace comprises six rooms of monumental importance, currently housing part of the Contemporary Art Collection of the Vatican Museums.



Along an itinerary that winds its way from the Borgia Apartment to the Sistine Chapel, visitors can admire approximately 8,000 works of 19th and 20th century Italian and international art. These pieces are signed by some of the most important artists of the time, including van Gogh, Bacon, Chagall, Carrà, de Chirico, Manzù, Capogrossi, Fontana, Burri and Matisse.



The tour of the Vatican Museums concludes by passing through the striking and original monumental double spiral helical staircase designed by the Italian architect and engineer Giuseppe Momo.



The Vatican Gardens are a green oasis of peace and tranquillity within the Vatican City. Currently, they extend from the south to the north-west of the city and occupy an area of approximately 23 hectares. Inside they are divided by zones, and contain buildings, fountains, statues and temples, some of which were designed by famous artists and architects such as Donato Bramante and Pirro Ligorio.
